******* Please submit a SINGLE Word document, including a one-page CV. Save your document under the filename “YourLastName-KadeTravel-2019” and send it as an attachment. The following information should be included:**

- 1) Curriculum Vita (résumé) (one page)
- 2) Dates and location of the intensive language courses to which you will apply, or proposed research project and
- 3) answer each of the following questions with a sentence or two:
 - a) How would you describe your current level of German?
 - b) How would you personally benefit from travel to Germany this summer?
 - c) Describe your plans and specify how this trip would impact your current or future academic or professional career.
 - d) Is there any other information you would like for us to consider?
